1. Call to order

Board of Supervisors Chairman Kennell called the meeting to order and the County Administrator, Judy Ownby, called the roll. The purpose of the meeting was to meet jointly with the Planning Commission in a work session to review proposed revisions to the subdivision ordinance.

Planning Commission Chairman Wheeler called the Planning Commission meeting to order and a quorum was established.

2. Review of Proposed Ordinance

Mr. Wheeler gave a power point presentation that highlighted major changes to the subdivision ordinance, stating that the goal is to adopt a clearer, cleaner ordinance that prepares

for the future and controls growth in the best interests of the County and its citizens.

Board members and staff made comments and asked questions about the ordinance. Chairman Wheeler noted that the Planning Commission will be presenting the ordinance to the public for comments and will ask the Board of Supervisors at a later date for another work session prior to public hearings.
